INTRODUCTION

Aims of the International Bibliography

The present issue contains a computerized and phototypeset International Bibliography on Computers and Law, the main purpose of which is to give an up-to-date reference aid on legal informatics to a wide range of users at a national and international level. In order to encourage and develop international communications and improve harmonization and unity within the Bibliography, English has been chosen as the main documentation language and English rules have been followed in the citation of bibliographical references, even though the Bibliography is published as a part of an Italian journal and the data has been compiled mostly by national centers. The International Bibliography on Computers and Law is a keyword-out-of-context (KWOC) index divided into three main parts: a keyword index, the bibliography itself, and an author index.

How to use the Kwoc Index

Words which arouse the particular interest of the reader may be found in the alphabetic keyword listing. When a given word is located, a glance underneath will reveal its relationship to the titles. Access to complete bibliographic information may be gained by matching each alphanumeric code printed under the keyword entry with the identical code appearing in progressive order in the Bibliography.

The names of all authors and the alphanumeric code of their works are listed in the Author Index. Access to the Bibliography may also be made through the Author Index.

Keyword Index

This is an automated list of relevant words or combinations of words which serve as descriptors of the contents of retrieved documents and which are listed in alphabetical order on the left-hand side of each page. These keywords are taken from the untranslated titles of English language publications, from the English translation of foreign language titles, from the English abstract of individual documents and from editorial insertions aimed at enlarging retrieval possibilities. For this purpose some connections between keywords of similar meaning have been indicated by the editorial staff. The titles pertaining to each keyword — completed with their English translation and alphanumeric code on the left which identifies the entry and refers the user to the Bibliography itself — appear automatically under the keyword.

A typical entry in the Keyword Index follows:

Bibliography

This is the main index: it contains complete bibliographical details of each analyzed entry and a short description of its content added in English by the editorial staff. The documents are ordered according to an alphanumeric code which refers the user from the Keyword or Author Index back to the Bibliography for full information.

A typical entry in the Bibliography follows:

The Register of inhibitions and Adjudications is the subject of the second development stage of the application of computer technology in the Department of the Registers of Scotland. The purpose of registration in the Register is to give notice to the public that persons inhibited or sequestered are unable to grant a good title should they wish to sell their heritable property. The Register consists of a series of minutes which are precis of each document registered. This system will give a quicker and more efficient service to solicitors and will save on typists. Source language: English.

The code consists of two parts. The first part arranges individual entries according to a Decimal Classification Table printed at the front of the Bibliography. The classification table, elaborated by the editorial staff, reveals document content using a 6-figure code corresponding to the six specification levels of the table. The first part of the code is on top of all documents pertaining to it and is completed with relative headings as contained in the classification table. The second part of the code refers to each single entry and precedes the author name. It consists of a 4-figure number representing the serial number of entries analyzed. A letter code follows, representing the nature of the analyzed entry: B = Books and Booklets; G = Grey Literature; M = Miscellaneous; P = Items derived from periodicals.

Author Index

This section lists all authors or editors (followed by «ed.») included in the index, along with the alphanumeric code that refers to entries in the Bibliography. It is arranged automatically in alphabetical order.

The authorship of anonymous entries is attributed to the journal in which they appear: in this case the name of the journal is given followed by «ed.».
