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Open Access, Digital Preservation and Semantic Web: the new era of a multi-disciplinary global publisher

The presentation will discuss the newly developed Open Access Policy “Open Choice”, the agreements reached in the field of the digital preservation and the newly developed partnerships in the field of semantic web.

Beyond the debate on Open Access, there is another, bigger challenge, both for researchers and publishers: how to manage the enormous growth of electronically available content. To allow for an easier access to scientific content, breakthrough indexing technologies are required to turn large amounts of heterogeneous publications into a single and comprehensive knowledge space. Implicit semantic relations between otherwise unrelated articles also need to be detected and made available to the reader through the identification of relevant concepts and relationships.
